*It is noted that the municipality has closed a portion of the Pilon road due to a landslide caused by the 2019 spring flood. The municipality is exploring different avenues of funding to repair the closed portion of the road. The MSP has denied financial aid by way of stating that the portion of the Pilon road which has been closed temporarily is not a necessary access route and that there are 2 alternate access routes available to

taxpayers. It is also noted that the municipality has blocked access to the damaged portion of the Pilon road and has posted signs to that effect.
