ROAD NETWORK

Regular repairs and maintenance are planned each spring and then executed throughout the spring, summer and fall seasons. The municipality received an annual increase of \$148 705 for the next four years (2018-2021) in road grant funds from the Provincial government. This year the amount will be spent on the installation of guardrails on sections of the Mountain and Hayes roads, as well as at the Halte. We have also allocated funds for (high) brushing of the Eight, Pilon, Litchfield Lake and Mountain roads. The balance of the grant increase will be used to replace multiple culverts on Stevenson, Bank, Ridge, Haley and Mountain roads.

The replacement of the large culvert on Mountain Road (Natt's creek) is also complete, the funds for this project were authorized from the provincial government road grant PAARRM and the Federal Excise Tax transfer (TECQ).

The relocation of the Laforet/ Hwy148 exit is in the final stages. We are waiting for the final approval from the CPTAQ, we are hoping to commence construction by the end of October 2018. The municipality received a grant for this project from the Provincial Government in the amount of \$353 415. The balance of the costs will be covered by the Federal Excise Tax transfer (TECQ). Therefore there will be no impact on the taxation.

TRANSFER CENTER

A storage container has been installed at the transfer site, the container will be used for large items and electronics. The reason for the container is to shield these items from the rain, therefore reducing the weight and the disposal cost.

MUNICIPAL HALTE

The municipal council is continuing the improvements at the Halte which will see the installation of a new guard rail/barrier in the parking area as well as the repairs to 3 more huts. In addition, it is with great pride, that we announce that council has purchased a wheelchair swing (to be installed shortly) which will benefit children and adults with special needs. To our knowledge, this will be the first swing of its kind to be installed in a public park in the Pontiac.

LITCHFIELD LEISURE COMMITTEE

The LLC has installed the Splash pad sponsor sign and is continuing with the installation of the benches and a multiple bay swing set which will provide swings for children with various needs. Council is working with the Litchfield Leisure Committee and supporting their efforts to provide a park environment for children and adults alike.

We thank the LLC for their continued efforts and dedication.
