EXTERNAL AUDITOR'S REPORT

Upon completion of its mandate, the auditor, in the independent auditor's report, is of the opinion that "the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Municipality of Litchfield as of December 31, 2020, and the results of their operations, changes in their net financial assets (net debt) and cash flows for the year then ended, in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for the public sector ".

FINANCIAL REPORT

For the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020, the financial report indicated revenues of \$1 451 767 plus a surplus appropriation \$130 613 and expenditures of \$1 228 994 (excluding amortization), capital investments of \$17 014 and payment of long-term debt of \$146 798 therefore resulting in a current year surplus of \$189 754. The total unappropriated surplus as of December 31st, 2020 was \$566 155.

REMUNERATION OF ELECTED OFFICIALS

Pursuant to section 11 of the Act Respecting the Remuneration of Elected Municipal Officers (LTEM), the secretary-treasurer of a local municipality whose by-law on remuneration is in force must publish, in the financial report of the local municipality, the remuneration and the allocation of expenses paid to elected officers, in 2020, for all of their duties held at the local municipal council.
